Rational:

2. Strengthening our relationship in Christ and Scouting of Asia Pacific region as a member of International Catholic Conference of Scouting.
3. Emphasizing the Youth involvement in every level of national level of our organizations and seek ways to build peace and better society which they will take responsibility.
4. Participants will discover and express the spiritual meaning in each activity and among group in general through joining in this Catholic Jamboree experience to their faith and values.
5. This Jamboree is an opportunity for each young person to share his/her spiritual/religious experience with others, practicing the communion spirituality and exchange Gospel's values among themselves and makes it as an integral and essential part in youth development.

Theme:

“Scout as a servant of the Gospels”
Duc in altum or Go into the deep based on the papal encyclical letter “Caritas Deus est” and “Spe salvi”. (God is Love and Salvific Hope). **It expresses in each activity by the process as the gospel taught us** “to come, meet each other and be friends through activities of caring, love and exchanging scouting skills to become leaders of more young people and foster each other’s life to the completion of truth, goodness and beauty.

This fee is transferable but non-refundable.

The fee includes transportation to campsite, [materials for jamboree](#), food and program supplies.

Other cost of tour in Thailand and the Home Hospitality are not included.

Participants:

All scouts and youth ministers in/of member countries of Asia Pacific Regional Catholic Conference of Scouting: **Korea, Japan, Singapore, Philippines, Malaysia, Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan, Vietnam, Laos, Indonesia, India, Myanmar, Papua New Guinea, Timor Leste, Thailand** and from scouts from member countries of Europe – Mediterranean region, Inter – America region and Africa region of ICCS.

Estimated numbers: 2,000 oversea Boy Scouts and Girl Guides/Scouts, age 12-18 years. And good numbers of Thai boy and girl scouts.

Service Teams: estimated 200 Rover Scouts and Adults in scouting.

Accommodations:

All Scouts: Scouts/Guides, Senior Scouts/Guides and Rovers will stay in Camping tents.

Food:

All meals will be cooked by their own patrol except lunch boxes for outside camp activities. Please check the meal schedule carefully.

We will prepare only equipments of cooking.

Climate at the Jamboree site: During 20-30 C.

Language:

English (assistance by translation in French, Spanish, Japanese, Korean, Chinese and Thai)
